Pierce County Al-Anon Needs Service Volunteers!

Al-Anon has experienced a scarcity of volunteers in the last few years. There are many opportunities for service available in Pierce County. Please consider how you might be able to give back to Al-Anon. If we don't nurture this program, it won't be self-supporting and available for future members in need. Service and sponsorship are cornerstones of the Al-Anon program. When we give back in love and gratitude, we deepen our program.

Service enhances our recovery. It can:

- increase our self-confidence and self-esteem
- help us get busy so we get better
- offer opportunities for fun and fellowship
- help us meet new Al-Anon friends and deepen relationships
- give us new opportunities to practice using the Al-Anon spiritual principles
- give us a greater understanding of the Al-Anon program and service structure

We are never alone when we take on a new service position. There are other members ready and willing to answer our questions, help and support us, and offer their experience, strength and hope. We do not need to be perfect, we just need willing hearts.

Ideally, each group would have a Group Representative, Alternate Group Representative, Secretary and Treasurer. Each group would also send a representative to their monthly District business meeting and to the monthly AIS meeting so information can flow back and forth between the links of service and members.

There are open service positions at the District level in both District 12 and 13. Pierce County Al-Anon Information Services also needs several committee members.

District 12 and 13 also need Al-Anon members to get certified as AMIAS's (Al-Anon Members Involved in Alateen Service) so we can support regular Alateen meetings in our Districts. Alateen meetings are an invaluable asset for teens struggling with someone else's drinking to receive experience, strength and hope.

Additionally, there are events that have not been held in since the pandemic due to lack of volunteers such as monthly Speaker Meeting potlucks and annual workshops. Opportunities to share your story at Speaker Meetings are also available.

Alateen, AMIAS, ASTAR, and WAAC Updates

AMIAS CERTIFICATION: The Al-Anon Member Involved in Alateen Service (AMIAS) Certification renewal window opened on January 15th, 2024 and will remain open through June 15th, 2024. The Area currently has 97 certified AMIAS. Of those 105 AMIAS, 73 still have to renew their certifications through me (again as of February 1, 2024.) Al-Anon members with two years of recovery may take a three-hour training over Zoom to become an AMIAS on February 10th at 9 AM. March 16 at 9 AM. May 8 at 9 AM or June 4 at 9 AM. Existing AMIAS may renew their certifications through three-hour Zoom sessions on February 10 at 1:00 PM. March 16 at 1:00 PM. May 8 at 1:00 PM or June 4th at 1:00 PM. These AMIAS training sessions will also be announced on the Area website and on the WA-AMIAS mailing list. ALATEEN GROUPS: We have ten active groups in the Area, in addition to the Monday night group hosted in the WSO's mobile app. We welcome the new Friday evening Alateen group in Lake Stevens. We hope that you will all support these and other Alateen groups in your Districts.

ALATEEN SPONSOR TRAINING AND RECOVERY (ASTAR): We will have a face-to-face ASTAR weekend April 12-14 at the Lazy F Camp in Ellensburg. Al-Anon members with at least two consecutive years of Al-Anon recovery may obtain or renew their AMIAS certification at ASTAR. Experienced AMIAS may become AMIAS trainers at ASTAR. Cost to attend is \$150 for the weekend. Please see your District folders or contact Michael S at alateen-safety@wa-al-anon.org for registration materials and other information.

Due to a lack of volunteers and interest, we are currently not holding the Second Saturday Speaker Meeting and potluck.


